Supplies needed:

Signs of Spring pattern

Rotary Cutter, Mat and Ruler

5 Yards of Wonder Under Iron on Adhesive with paper backing (do not substitute)

Parchment Paper for Appliqué, (get the white not the tan)

Freezer paper

Elmer's Washable purple school glue stick (do not substitute)

Liquid Stitch permanent fabric glue (do not substitute)

Coordinating Sewing Thread

Sewing Machine

Basic Sewing Supplies

Fabric:

For the 35 Block Background:

Assorted Fat 1/8's or Scraps in Pale Pastels for Basket Backgrounds (I used 1 ½ yds of the same color)

Assorted Fat 1/8's or Scraps in Pastels for Baskets

For the Appliqué and Borders:

Scraps or 1/8 Yard Each of Four Different Greens

Scraps or 1/8 Yard for Bunny

Scraps or 1/8 Yard for Purple Cone Flowers

Scraps or 1/8 Yard for Day Lilies

¼ Yard or Fat Quarter for Watering Can

¼ Yard or Fat Quarter for Birdhouse and Pole

Scraps for Other Smaller Appliqué Pieces

¼ Yard for Inside Border

½ Yard for Outside Border

1/3 Yard for Binding

1 1/8 Yard for Backing

Please bring to class:

Before class:

1. Have your fabric marked for what you are using where.

Note – Since we will not be using the designer’s technique I will be furnishing the following:

1. 2 paper piecing sheets for the background baskets and instructions. You can copy the others yourself.
2. freezer paper with pattern pieces on it mirror imaged.
3. a copy of the working design.
4. cardboard for a design wall
